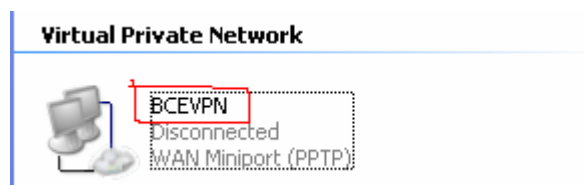


New PC with VPN to CSIONet

- 1) Download setuppc.exe from MASTERCOM's web site
<http://www.mastercom.com/pwrbrker>
- 2) Run setuppc.exe and reboot.
Setuppc.exe will search for the \EMAIL directory located on your server.
- 3) Check that you are on at least 6.4g of the BrokerEDI/PCE-Mail Engine by clicking the Start button, point to Programs, click "BrokerEDIPC E-Mail Engine" and then "Settings - Schedule". To download the latest update go MASTERCOM's web site <http://www.mastercom.com/pwrbrker>. Click "up64g.EXE" to download the BrokerEDI/PC E-Mail/EDI Engine Version 6.4g update. **Note: When you enter your Product ID put in a 0 before the 396.**
- 4) To add VPN to your CSIONet account call CSIO at 416-360-1773.
- 5) For this VPN support, the BrokerEDI/PC E-Mail/EDI Engine must be run from a Windows 2000 or Windows XP Professional Workstation or Server.
- 6) Create a VPN dial-up networking entry **e.g. BCEVPN** Note: the network connection name cannot have any spaces. Call BCE Nexxia BEBN's help line 1-888-926-2222 for help in configuring the Entry.



Firewall should be configured to forward traffic on port 500UDP and 1723 to the IP address of the connecting machine. Enable IP protocol 47 which is normally enabled on most routers.

For the Antivirus software "xmailer.exe" and "xmailer.d.exe" located in the EMAIL\MHS\MAIL\GATES\ICENET\PUBLIC directory should have rights to ports 25 and 110. Do not intercept/scan email going out on port 25 sent by "xmailer.exe" and "xmailer.d.exe" See "Firewall & Antivirus Setups Info Sheet"

- 7) Choose the program-item icon labeled Settings - InsureNet to specify the following settings:
 - Communications Options: - Dedicated Connection
 - BCE Emergis VPN Connection
 - Network and Dial-up Connection Names: BCE Emergis VPN Connection
Note: this name cannot have any spaces. **e.g. BCEVPN**
