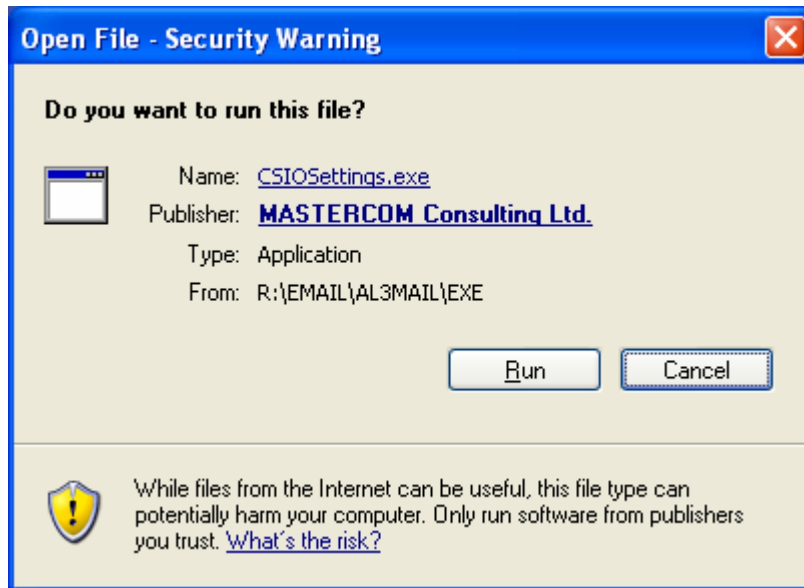


Open File – Security Warning

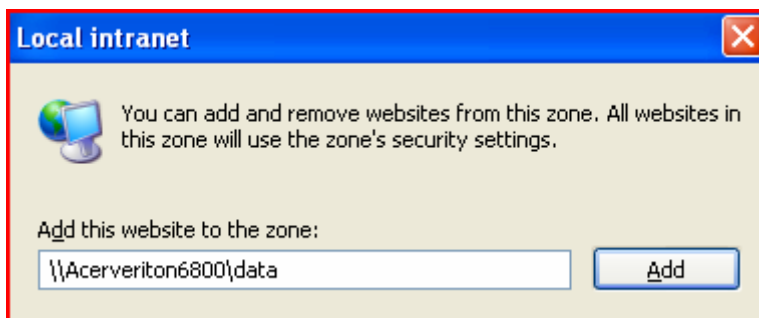
Even after programs have been trusted, Windows Internet Explorer 7 insists on issuing Security Warnings for programs being started from a mapped drive.

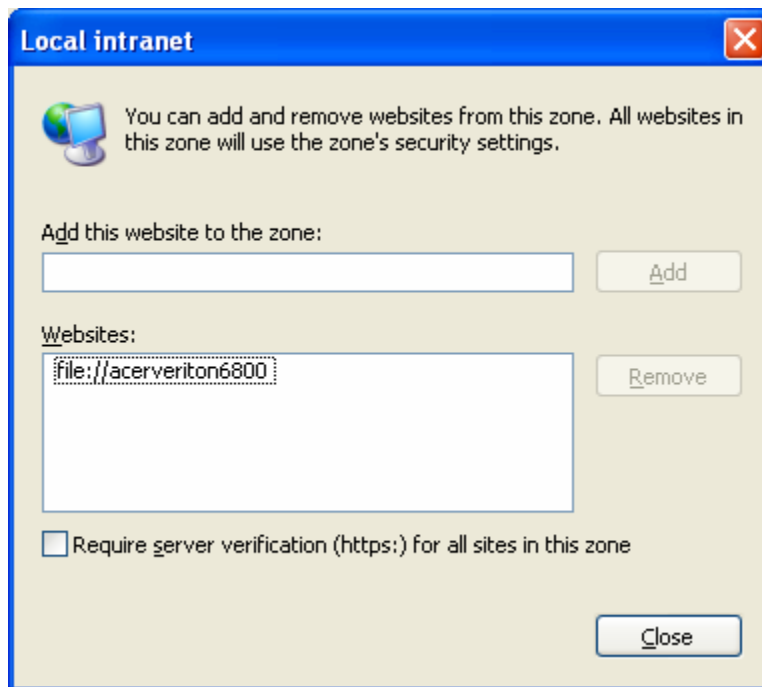


The **WORKAROUND** is as given in the Microsoft Knowledge Base Article **Intranet site is identified as an Internet site when you use an FQDN or an IP address** - <http://support.microsoft.com/kb/303650/en-us>

To work around this behavior, each user must add the appropriate UNC path to the Local Intranet Sites dialog box:

1. In Internet Explorer, click **Tools**, and then click **Internet Options**.
2. On the **Security tab**, click **Local intranet**, and then click **Sites**.
3. Click **Advanced**, and then type: the “**UNC path of the MASTERCOM Gateway share**” as illustrated below. Add this Web site to the zone box,





4. Click **Add**, click **Close**, click **OK**, and then click **OK** again to close the Internet Options dialog box.
5. Restart the computer.
