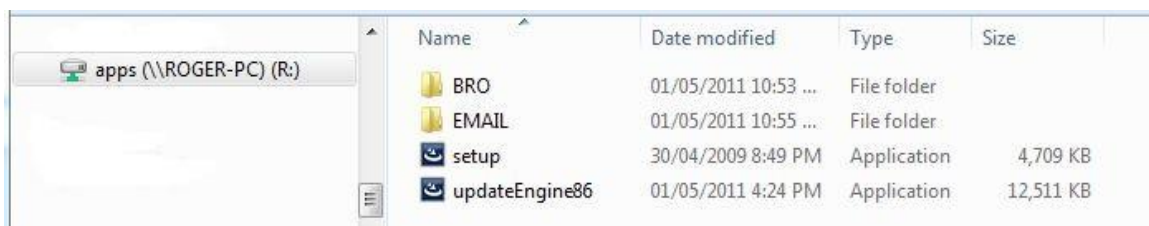


Upgrade to Version 8.6c Steps

The upgrade to Version 8.6c of the BrokerEDIPC E-Mail-EDI Engine supports attachments to the policy download. Now you can receive your broker copy of the dec-pages electronically as a PDF document and stored automatically by Power Broker in the Customer Abeyance/Notes Database.

- 1) Go to the user's PC that will run the upload/download communications.
- 2) Download **updateEngine86c.exe** from MASTERCOM's web site and save it in the mapped drive where the folders \EMAIL and \BRO resides, as illustrated below. In this case the mapped drive is R.




- 3) Double-click **updateEngine86c.exe** and accept all the default settings to install the update
- 4) If the upgrade is **from Version 7.7f** then you must select **“Settings – Main”** in the **“BrokerEDIPC E-Mail-EDI Engine .NET”** program folder and click the **OK** button.

Windows 7 64 bit or Windows SBS/Server 2008

If your operating system is Windows 7 64 bit or Windows SBS/Server 2008 the program path for nlauncher.exe must be changed to **C:\Program Files (x86)\Juniper Networks\Network Connect 6.1.0**

- 1) Click Start, All Programs, “BrokerEDIPC E-Mail-EDI Engine .NET”, **“Settings – CSIONet”**
- 2) **“Connection”** should be “Connect using SSL VPN”
- 3) Juniper Network Connect SSL VPN – **Login Method** is “Juniper NcLauncher Login”
- 4) Click the **“Parameter Settings”** button Check that the program path for nlauncher.exe is **C:\Program Files (x86)\Juniper Networks\Network Connect 6.1.0**


