

Power Broker Forms E-Mail Attachment Option

MASTERCOTM's CSIO Mail options now includes support for the standard Internet e-mail attachments.

Power Broker Users and their insurance companies can now send the regular e-mail attachments over the secure CSIONet/Telus SSL VPN connection.

Canada's "Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act" requires the protection of personal information. Gone is the need to fax or courier documents containing a clients' personal information. They can now be sent over CSIONet, the secure network, provided by Telus.

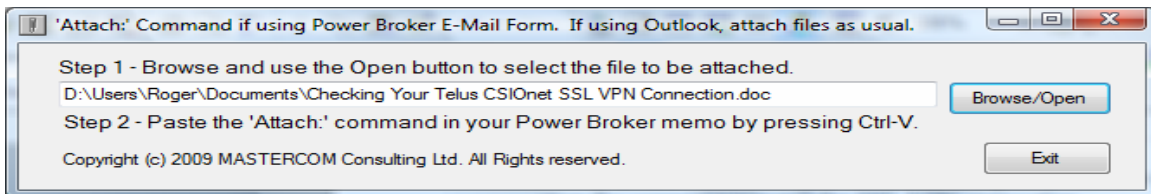
Power Broker users select the file to be attached and then pastes the "Attach:" command into Power Broker's E-Mail Form message. To access the list of received attachments, the user selects the "Rec'd CSIO E-Mail Attachments" icon on the desktop, as shown below.

Attaching Files to a Power Broker E-Mail Message.

Files are attached to a Power Broker E-Mail Form message by using MASTERCOTM's "Attach File Command" located on the user's desktop, as shown below.



- 1) Browse and use the Open button to select the file to be attached. Note: The Open button does not open the file but merely selects the file so it can be copied to the "EMAIL\AL3MAIL\AttachmentsSend" directory on the server for attachment.



- 2) Press Ctrl-V to paste the "Attach:" command into the message, as illustrated below.
